FREQUENT CHECKS

Before each use or after a fall

HANDLEBAR ASSEMBLY

Confirm Front & Rear light functionality
Stem – Torque mounting hardware
Brake Lever – Firm feel with lever at least 1/3 inch from grip when fully pressed
Anti-Ejection functional
ON/OFF switch functional
Throttle returning to “off” position

SKI ASSEMBLY

Front shock – Check 2 eyelet bolts and preload bolt
Upper Fork Clamp – Check screws
Fork - Check Thru-axle is tight

CHASSIS

Check snow guard screws
Check foot peg screws
Check 4 track assembly frame screws

BATTERY BOX

Box sealed (no visual gaps, to avoid snow to get in)
Charging cover closed and locked
Battery box locked

REAR BRAKE

Check 4 mounting screws
Check banjo connector screw

MOTOR AXLE FASTENERS

Check 2 motor bolts (1 per side)
Check 4 tensile bolts (2 per side)

TRACK ASSEMBLY

Check screws (each side)
Visual check 2 cotter pins on each shock
Check track tension
